The tour

Literary critic Ragnhildur Árnadóttir, former employee of the Reykjanesbær library, will lead a literary walk that follows the novel "Fiskar hafa enga fætur" or in English "The Fish Have No Legs" by Jón Kalman Stefánsson.

The walk will lead you into the time of the U.S. base, from its establishment in 1951 and through to the present.

You will become familiar with the different stories of people that form a colorful and intense web of fate binding together the individuals, the nation, and most of all the working class.

Prepare for the tour: Dress according to weather, sturdy shoes and a hat is always a good choice for Icelandic nature. Bring swimsuit for the chance to dip your toes in the milky blue waters at the Blue Lagoon.
